### **Pay and conditions**

Remuneration will be between 38.000 – 40.000 EUR full-time equivalent per annum depending on experience. EN offers 30 days annual leave, regular home-working, a Macbook air laptop, I-phone and a pension scheme. The employer is open to discussing 0.8-1.0 full-time role (32-40 hours).

From time to time, you will be required to work beyond usual business hours and to travel within Europe.
